



## California State Preschool Program

- Low to Moderate Income Families
- Full and Part Day Services
- For children 3 and 4 years of age
- Fee based on Gross Monthly Income
- 5 Locations in North County
- Kindergarten Readiness

### A. Family qualifications for **Part-Day, Part year** state preschool services: **Eligibility Only**

1. Family is a public assistance recipient
2. Family is income eligible
3. The family is homeless
4. The family has a child who is at risk of abuse, neglect, or exploitation or receiving child protective services through the County Welfare Department.

### B. Family qualifications for **Full-Day, Full Year** state preschool services: **Eligibility (A) and Need**

1. Child protective services or at risk of abuse, neglect, or exploitation
2. The parent(s) and any other adult counted in the family size are engaged in any of the following
  - a. Employed
  - b. Seeking Employment
  - c. Participating in vocational training leading directly to a recognized trade, para-profession, or profession
  - d. Family is homeless and seeking permanent housing for family stability
  - e. Incapacitated

### C. Information required for all children

1. Birth Certificate
2. Immunization Record
3. Address verification

### D. Information required for parent

1. Income documentation
2. Documentation of Need (If applicable)
